



## **Remis' Formula**

### **Formula:**

$$RT=(14*(7-X))+(16-Y)+Z/30$$

### **Variables:**

RT – rating

X – team division (A=1; B=2; C=3; ...; G=7)

Y – team position in division

Z – SP manager ranking points

### **Code of Conduct**

#### **I**

-15<sup>th</sup> position in the higher division is equal to the 1<sup>st</sup> position in lower division;

-16<sup>th</sup> position in the higher division is equal to the 2<sup>nd</sup> position in lower division;

Explanation: 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> positions would be promoted, 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> would be relegated

#### **II**

Significant step in SP manager ranking is **30** points. If the team in 14<sup>th</sup> position in higher division has 30 points less than the team in the 1<sup>st</sup> position in the lower division, means their ranking is equal.

Explanation: 30 points – 30 League matches during the season.

#### **III**

If teams have equal number of RT then higher team in the tanking list is:

1. Higher position in the division
2. Manager's SP playtime is longer (The club was registered earlier)

The main, most important and significant advantage of this formula is:

- SP manager ranking position is not included. (!!)
- Manager ranking points are used instead. (!!)
